NSS Special Camp Report at Ayyalur Village, Kurnool District

12th February-18th February 2018

National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit OF *SVR Engineering College* organized a special camp in an adopted village, Ayyalur of Nandyal Mandal, Kurnool District;

Day-I

The forenoon session of the Day began with a Procession by NSS volunteers in the village. Volunteers rallied into the streets of the village to create awareness among the villagers about the ensuing special camp program in their village for a period of one week.

Sarpanch of the Village and several village people attended to the inaugural function. Village authorities welcomed the team of Volunteers into their village and assured them all sorts of co-operation needed in making the special camp a success.

During the Afternoon session of the First Day, Volunteers went to the houses of villagers and informed the people about the ODF programme. The NSS teams inform people about the demerits of open defecation. They also motivated the people to construct toilets in their houses and informed about the government assistance being provided for it.

Volunteers visited Anganwadi centers and other Zilla Parishad schools. Volunteers created awareness by making door to door campaign on cleanliness, spread of diseases, and importance of environment and judicious use of Electricity, water harvesting and importance of ground water.

Day – 2

In the dawn of the second Day, volunteers started their campaign by contacting the villagers who were going for open defecation. They made them aware about the diseases caused by open defecation. In the day time a survey was conducted to know the basic toilet facilities in the houses of the villagers.

In the camp volunteers organized a Shramadanam Programme. About 50 volunteers divided themselves into sub groups and went into the streets, lanes and by lanes of the village and organized a cleanliness drive. Volunteers cleaned the village roads, removed dust heaps and cleared the stagnant drainage flows and attempted to create awareness on Cleanliness and hygiene. They swept with brooms on the roads of the village.

Day-3

The Forenoon Session of third day began with door to door contact with village people for the use of toilets and avoids the habits of open defecation. Volunteers also identified those village people who do not have toilet facility in their homes.

The Third day of the camp was full of events, it was mainly dedicated to Plantation Program, role play on the health and cleanliness and a dance competition of youngsters. Volunteers collected about 100 saplings from nearby. Villagers encouraged the volunteers by joining the plantation program.

A public announcement was made and door to door communication was done by our volunteers to inform people to avail free health services. The health check up camp was proved very successful and created a harmonious environment in the community.

In the afternoon session, volunteers organized a musical chair game for the students of 8th and 9th class students and walking race with lemon in spoon for 10th class students.

Day – 6

NSS Volunteers conducted carrier guidance for 10th class students. Principal Dr. P.Mallikarjuna Reddy and Managing Director Mr.S.Dinesh Reddy of SVR Engineering College have distributed the prizes to the winners of various events conducted by the NSS Volunteers.

Principal and MD also presented the Exams Kits (Pad, Pen, Scale, Eraser, Sharpener) to 10th class students who are going to write Public Examination in March-2018.


